NOTIFICATION

G. O. (Rt.) No. 458/2014/LBR. Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 31st March, 2014.

S. R. O. No. 232/2014.—In exercise of the powers conferred by rule 8 of the Kerala Factories (Welfare Officers) Rules, 1957, the Government of Kerala hereby exempt Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd., Ambalamugal, Ernakulam from the operation of the provisions contained in sub-rules (1) and (2) of rule 5 of the said rules, subject to the following conditions, namely:—

(1) This exemption is valid till the recruitment of new Welfare Officer by following the procedure laid under rule 5 of the Kerala Factories (Welfare Officers) Rules, 1957.

(2) This exemption is granted only for the appointment of a temporary Welfare Officer, who has got qualifications as prescribed under Rule 4 of the said Rules.

(3) The exemption now granted is subject to modification or revision or withdrawal on sufficient grounds as the Government deems fit without notice when circumstances arise.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

M/s. Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd., Ambalamugal, Ernakulam has requested for exemption from the operation of provisions of sub-rules (1) and (2) of rule 5 of the Kerala Factories (Welfare Officers) Rules, 1957 for appointing Sri Sreekumar, Deputy General Manager (Plan A) as Welfare Officer, in their factory taking into account of the fact that the person has got required qualification and experience and his appointment would be beneficial to the company, in the area of employee's welfare as well as in fulfilling the social responsibility. Government have decided to grant exemption from the operation of sub-rule (1) and (2) of rule 5 of the said rules to M/s. Hindustan Organic Chemicals Ltd., Ambalamugal, Ernakulam for the appointment of a temporary Welfare Officer subject to the above conditions.

This notification is intended to achieve the above object.
